UPDATE - CONSTRUCTION WORK IN YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD (CAWTRA RD. AND HAYCINTHE BLVD.)

As previously communicated, the Region of Peel has started the construction of the Cawthra Rd. Sanitary Sewer and Watermain, Phase 2 project. This work is part of the Region's multi-phased project to reduce basement flooding by diverting wastewater flow away from areas prone to surcharging, as well as expanding sanitary sewer capacity and upgrading the water system capacity and reliability.

This notice is to inform you that we will install a temporary construction shaft at the intersection of Cawthra Rd and Hyacinthe Blvd.

SCHEDULE

On or about January 4, 2021, we will start the equipment mobilization and traffic controls setup. Work is expected to be completed in 6 weeks.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

For the entire duration of this work, access to Hyacinthe Blvd. from Cawthra Rd will be temporarily closed. Traffic on Cawthra Road will be reduced to one (1) southbound lane and two (2) northbound lanes from North of Breckenridge Rd to South of Hyacinthe Blvd. These traffic closure/impacts are necessary to continue the works safely in your neighbourhood.

The temporary road closure and traffic impacts will commence on or about January 4, 2021, and is expected to be fully restored to normal on February 18, 2020.

REDUCING THE IMPACT OF CONSTRUCTION

- We will manage traffic to minimize disruption to vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians.
- Regular working hours will be 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.

TRAFFIC, DRIVEWAY AND PARKING INFORMATION

- Due to construction activities, we may need to block your driveway for a short time. We will contact you before we do this to arrange for the best time and for alternate access, if needed.
- On-street parking will be reduced during construction.

NOISE AND VIBRATION LEVEL

Due to construction activities, the noise level at the intersection of Cawthra Rd and Hyacinthe Blvd. or nearby this intersection should be medium and some vibration might be felt.
