Project Overview

Gulleden Park is a 5.3-acre (2.14-hectare) park located within the Applewood neighbourhood of Ward 3. Burnhamthorpe Community Centre is located to the north of the park. Saint Sofia and Glenhaven Sr. Public Schools are east of the park and residential neighbourhoods are located to the south and west.

Current park amenities include an unlit softball diamond, two soccer fields, and two lit pickleball/tennis courts. The City of Mississauga is starting the redevelopment process of this park and is seeking feedback from residents to understand what type of park experience and amenities could best serve the community.

Burnhamthorpe Community Centre Renovation and Expansion Project

The City is renovating and expanding Burnhamthorpe Community Centre to meet the needs of the Rathwood-Applewood community by constructing a new aquatic and fitness centre as well as improving infrastructure to address population growth and changing demographics in the area.

Redevelopment of the Community Centre will begin in spring 2021, during this time the building and site will be closed to the public for construction and is anticipated to re-open in spring/summer 2023. Outdoor Ice Rink

During design phase for the redevelopment of the Burnhamthorpe Community Centre, it became clear that the outdoor rink would need to be removed given that the rink has come to the end of its lifecycle.

However, because of COVID-19 restrictions, the City has seen an increased demand for public skating, and residents have indicated a desire to replace the outdoor rink at a new location. Subject to the feedback from the public engagement for the redevelopment of Gulleden Park, the City will consider a new outdoor refrigerated skating facility as part of the planned park redevelopment.

Your Opinion Matters

Due to COVID-19, the City has postponed in-person public engagement activities based on public health recommendations and the need for physical distancing. Your feedback matters and the City is seeking help to understand what amenities residents want to see prioritized in the redeveloped Gulleden Park through an online survey (a copy of which has been included in this mailing). City staff will continue to engage with the public to confirm the findings of the feedback and ensure the redeveloped park meets community needs.
